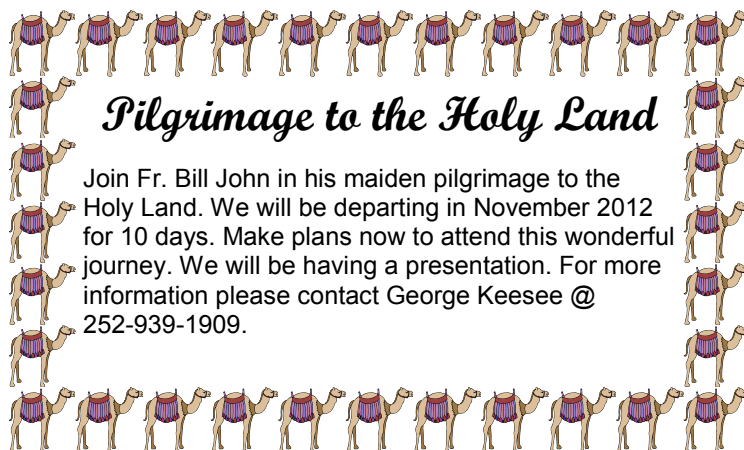

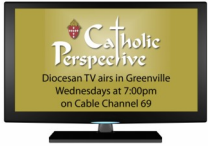
Right to Life March

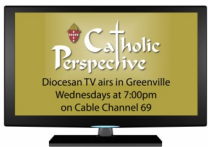

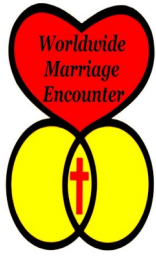
